Monday, February 8

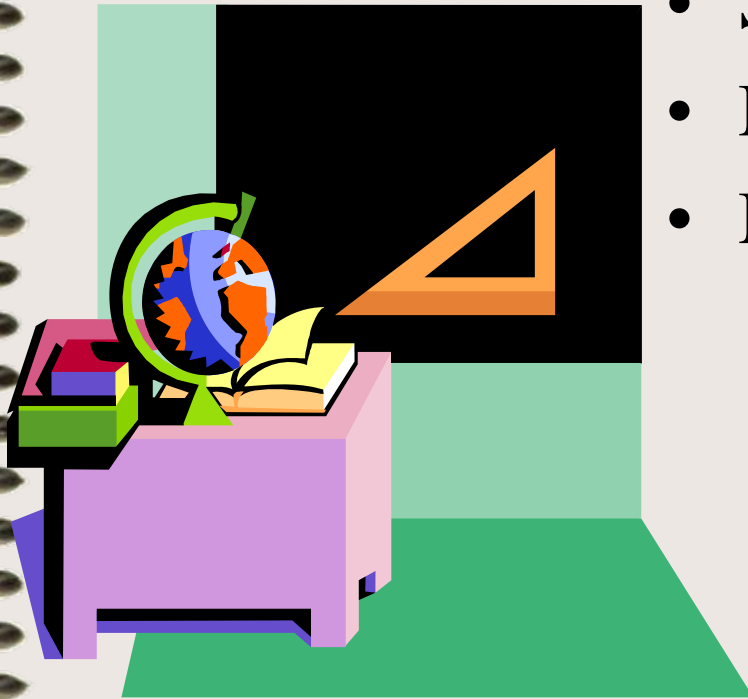
- Program of Studies distributed at level meetings.

February 22-April 2:

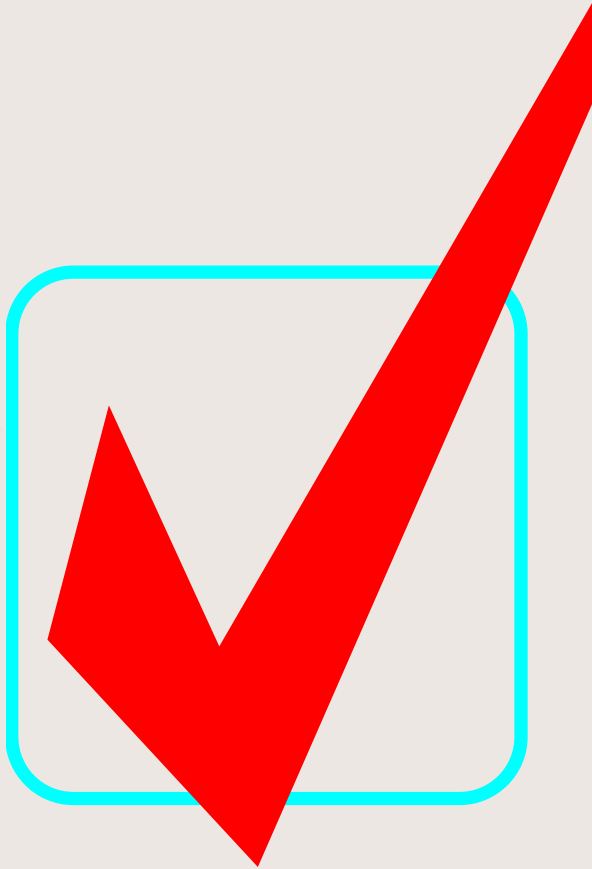
Consultation Period: Students discuss options with parents and teachers. Students may also request appointments with their Guidance Counselor to discuss their course selections.

Course Selection will be finalized via **COURSE REQUEST WORKSHEETS**.

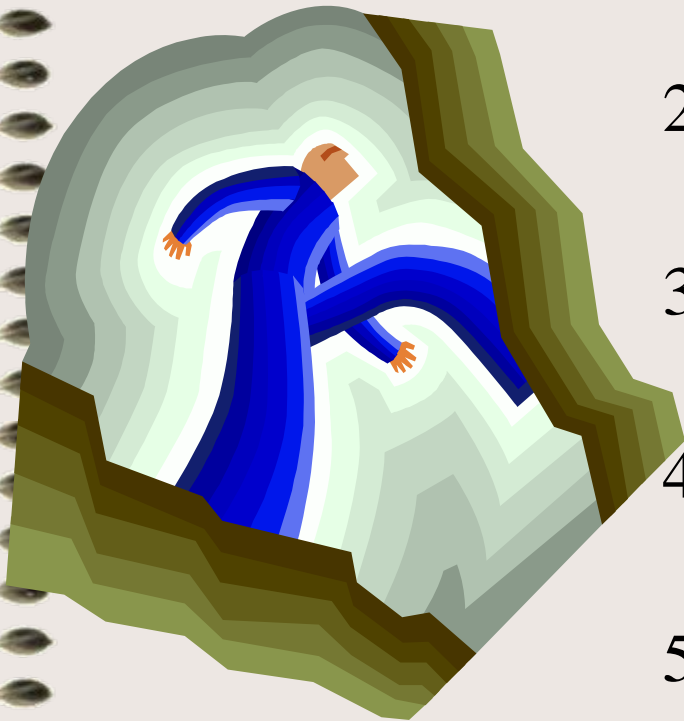
Students will register for 2010-2011 in three steps
