Experience Knowledge

The academic program and schedule at Cardinal Spellman High School has been carefully designed to offer our students an educational experience that is rigorous, challenging and engaging in the context of a Christian community. Required core courses are offered at a variety of levels including College Preparatory, Honors and Advanced Placement, and the program is enhanced with expansive elective course options in every subject area. Required courses in English, Mathematics, World Languages, Theology, Science, and Social Studies form the core curriculum.

A variety of elective courses are offered to enrich the core curriculum including: Government & Politics, Psychology, Engineering, Bioethics, American Sign Language, Visual Art, SAT Prep, and Forensics.

Additionally, Spellman partners with Virtual High School (VHS) to offer a wide variety of on-line courses for full credit, as well as a Dual Enrollment Program with Stonehill College, whereby students can receive college level credit in several subject areas.

Spellman's skilled and experienced teachers present the curriculum in a holistic approach, teaching to the mind and spirit of each student, maximizing their strengths and gifts and emphasizing a desire for service.

Have Your Current School Submit Your Transcript to CSHS

- Complete the top section of the Transcript Request form making sure that it bears your parent's/guardian's signature.
- Bring the Transcript Request form promptly to your counselor or eighth grade teacher.
- Request that your counselor or eighth grade teacher complete the Transcript Record and send it to Cardinal Spellman High School.
- **Deadline: Jan. 10, 2023**
