The academic program and schedule at Cardinal Spellman High School has been carefully designed to offer our students an educational experience that is rigorous, challenging and engaging in the context of a Christian community. Required core courses are offered at a variety of levels including College Preparatory, Honors and Advanced Placement. and the program is enhanced with expansive elective course options in every subject area. Required courses in English, Mathematics, World Languages, Theology, Science, and Social Studies form the core curriculum.

A variety of elective courses are offered to enrich the core curriculum including: Government & Politics, Psychology, Engineering, Bioethics, American Sign Language, Visual Art, SAT Prep, and Forensics.

Additionally, Spellman partners with Virtual High School (VHS) to offer a wide variety of on-line courses for full credit, as well as a Dual Enrollment Program with Stonehill College, whereby students can receive college level credit in several subject areas.


With the support of their teachers, college counselors and parents, we urge all our students to pursue a program that is as motivating and challenging as possible in order to:
